

Thirty Two Rods to a Stake Thence West Twenty five Rods
to a Sugar Tree Thence North Thirty Two Rods to a Stake
Thence East Twenty five Rods to the beginning corner.
Originally granted to the aforesaid Marmaduke Coate by
Letters made patent at the City of Washington bearing

-dred and Nine Together with all and singular the Right
